



PAYDAY

Section 1 – Race Format

This is a timed SXS obstacle course competition with two classes based on tire size.

- Small Bills: ≤41.5-inch tires – Rock Garden required.
- Big Bills: >41.5-inch tires – Mud Pit required.

Running the incorrect obstacle results in disqualification (DQ).

Clean Run: Completed run within time limits, without false starts or outside assistance. Winching is allowed.

If no clean run is completed, placement is based on furthest progress and fastest time per class.

Each racer receives one official run.

Additional runs may be purchased on-site as a buy-back only as time allows. No guarantee is implied. Buy-back order and availability are at officials' discretion.

Racers may change wheels/tires and enter both classes. Entry fee applies per racer per class entry. Staging time limits apply to all racers, including those entering multiple classes.

Tire size is measured mounted. Tech inspection determines class. Officials' decisions are final.

Section 2 – Pre-Run

Pre-run will be held Friday, May 29, 2026 at 3:00 PM CST.

Online registration prior to May 29, 2026 is required.

One pre-run lap per racer.

All safety and vehicle requirements apply during pre-run.

Section 3 – Entry & Fees

Entry Fee: \$125 per racer per class entry.

Buy-back runs: \$100 per attempt, only as time allows.

All fees are non-refundable.

Mandatory Driver's Meeting: Saturday, May 30, 2026 at 1:00 PM CST. Failure to attend results in immediate disqualification.

Section 4 – Safety & Vehicle Requirements

Powersports engines only.

Vehicles are subject to tech inspection at any time. Officials' decisions are final.

- DOT/SNELL helmet
- Eye Protection
- Minimum 4-point non-retractable harness
- Full doors (OEM allowed)
- Roll cage

Section 5 – On-Course Rules

No unauthorized person may enter or remain on the PAYDAY course during active competition. Access is restricted to designated race officials only while racing is active.

Only one contestant is permitted on the course at a time.

Course boundaries must be respected.

Breaking or crossing course tape or flags results in a 15-second time penalty per occurrence.

Rubbing or brushing tape or flags is permitted.

Winching allowed by driver operation only. No outside assistance.

Outside assistance includes physical contact or verbal guidance from outside the vehicle.

Maximum run time: 5 minutes.

2-minute staging rule strictly enforced.



Section 6 – Timing & Scoring

Laser timing will be used with manual backup.

If no clean run is completed within a class, placement will be determined by furthest course progress and fastest recorded time.

Ties will be resolved by sudden-death runoff.

Section 7 – Payout Structure

Payout is per class Small/Big Bills:

- 1st Place – \$3,000
- 2nd Place – \$1,500
- 3rd Place – \$500

Section 8 – Event Schedule Requirements

All racers must arrive by 12:00 PM CST Saturday, May 30, 2026.

Mandatory Driver's Meeting: 1:00 PM CST Saturday.

Racing begins at or after 5:00 PM CST. Night lighting provided.

Failure to comply with schedule requirements may result in disqualification.

Section 9 – Vehicle Recovery

Vehicle recovery is at the competitor's risk.

Event staff may assist at their discretion but assume no liability for damage occurring during recovery operations.

Section 10 – Conduct Policy

Zero-tolerance conduct policy is enforced.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, reckless behavior, harassment, intoxication, or actions deemed detrimental to the event may result in disqualification, forfeiture of winnings, removal from event grounds, and/or ban from future events.



Section 11 – Competition Authority

Officials may stop competition at any time for safety.

Officials may inspect vehicles at any time.

Officials' decisions are final.

Section 12 – Liability & Assumption of Risk

Participation in PSE PAYDAY 2026 is voluntary and at the sole risk of the competitor.

Motorsports competition involves inherent risks including vehicle damage, personal injury, serious bodily harm, or death.

Competitors assume full responsibility for their vehicle, safety equipment, conduct, and any damages caused by their actions.

Event promoters, property owners, sponsors, officials, staff, and affiliates are not responsible for personal injury, death, property damage, theft, mechanical failure, or actions of others.

All competitors must sign the official event waiver prior to participation.

Officials reserve the right to remove any competitor or vehicle deemed unsafe without refund.

Section 13 – Competition Authority & Enforcement

All decisions made by race officials are final and not subject to appeal.

Race officials have full authority over rule interpretation, penalty assessment, timekeeping, class determination, safety enforcement, and operational control.

No video or third-party footage may be used to challenge or overturn an official ruling unless requested by race officials.

Officials retain authority to enforce both the letter and spirit of these rules.

OFFICIAL LIABILITY WAIVER, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND RULEBOOK ACKNOWLEDGMENT AGREEMENT

Event Dates: May 29–30, 2026

In consideration of being permitted to participate in PSE PAYDAY 2026, the undersigned participant agrees to the following:

1. ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I acknowledge that motorsports competition involves inherent and significant risks, including but not limited to vehicle damage, mechanical failure, collision, personal injury, serious bodily harm, permanent disability, or death. I voluntarily assume full responsibility for all risks associated with participation, whether known or unknown, foreseeable or unforeseeable.

2. RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue PSE PAYDAY, event promoters, property owners, sponsors, officials, staff, volunteers, affiliates, and their respective agents from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, demands, actions, or causes of action arising out of or related to any loss, damage, injury, or death that may be sustained while participating in or attending this event.

3. RULEBOOK ACKNOWLEDGMENT

I acknowledge that I have received, read, and understand the official PSE PAYDAY 2026 Rulebook. I agree to comply with all rules, safety requirements, class determinations, penalties, and operational procedures outlined therein. I understand that race officials have full authority over rule interpretation, enforcement, safety determinations, and competition outcomes, and that all decisions are final and not subject to appeal.

4. RESPONSIBILITY

I accept full responsibility for my vehicle, equipment, safety gear, conduct, and compliance with event standards both on and off the course.

5. VEHICLE RECOVERY & DAMAGE

I understand that vehicle recovery assistance, if provided, is performed at my own risk. I agree that event staff and affiliates are not liable for damage occurring during recovery operations.



6. CONDUCT POLICY

I agree to abide by the event's zero-tolerance conduct policy. Unsportsmanlike conduct, reckless behavior, harassment, or actions deemed detrimental to the event may result in disqualification, forfeiture of winnings, removal from the event grounds, and/or ban from future events.

7. MEDICAL CONSENT

In the event of injury or medical emergency, I authorize event officials to secure medical treatment on my behalf if deemed necessary. I accept full financial responsibility for any medical services rendered.

8. WAIVER VALIDITY

I certify that I am at least 18 years of age, or that I have obtained legal guardian consent below. I have read this agreement carefully, fully understand its terms, and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement.
